3. Death and Total and Permanent Disablement (TPD) insurance

Self-employed persons who are Personal members of legalsuper receive \$250,000 of Fixed Death and TPD insurance cover automatically upon joining legalsuper, subject to a Pre Existing Condition restriction. Spouse members of the Fund may only apply for Death only insurance cover.

4. Salary Continuance insurance
