#### Accepting personal contributions

If you are aged between 65 and 74, you are required to complete a declaration confirming your employment each financial year in which you or your employer contributes into your superannuation account.

To be eligible to contribute, you must have been gainfully employed for at least 40 hours within a period of 30 consecutive days in the financial year in which you or your employer made a contribution.

#### For contributions made after 1 July 2020

You are also eligible to contribute for 12 months from the end of the financial year in which you last met the work test, provided that your total superannuation balance is below \$300,000.

# **Important information**

## Who should complete this election?

You should complete this election if contributions have been made to your super from the disposal of a certain small business asset, and you:

- want to exclude these contributions from the non-concessional contributions cap, and
- have not reached your \$1.515 million CGT cap amount (for income year 2020/21) – this amount is indexed on an annual basis and rounded down to the nearest \$5,000.

Please note that this election must be made and given to legalsuper before or at the time you make the contribution it applies to.

An election made after the contribution it refers to is not valid. Your contribution will not be excluded from the non-concessional contributions cap. legalsuper will not be permitted to report to the ATO that a valid election was made.

#### Important note

You should seek professional advice that takes into account your circumstances and eligibility to make this contribution. If you are ineligible to make this contribution, you may be subject to a significant tax liability, and your contribution is non-refundable.

## Tax file number (TFN) details

Under the *Superannuation Industry (Supervision) Act 1993,* legalsuper is authorised to collect, use and disclose your TFN.

legalsuper may disclose your TFN to another superannuation provider, when your benefits are being transferred, unless you request legalsuper, in writing, not to disclose your TFN to any other superannuation provider.

Declining to quote your TFN to legalsuper is not an offence. However giving your TFN to legalsuper will have the following advantages:

- legalsuper will be able to accept all permitted types of contributions to your account/s;
- other than the tax that may ordinarily apply, you will not pay more tax than you need to. This affects both contributions to your superannuation and benefit payments when you start drawing down your superannuation benefits; and
- it will make it much easier to find different superannuation accounts in your name so that you receive all your superannuation benefits when you retire.
