- B iii) Industrial bodies are defined in legislation as organisations registered under the Fair Work (Registered Organisations) Act 2009. legalsuper makes payments to the Australian Services Union and the United Services Union as part of salary payments to certain directors as instructed by those relevant directors.
- B iv) Related party payments include remuneration paid to directors who are associated with the Law Institute of Victoria and the Law Society of NSW and sponsorship payments made to these organisations (legalsuper's shareholders).
